A Visit from the Federal Transit Administration

On September 16th, Casco Bay Lines updated the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) on progress being made to Battery Steele during an event featuring the FTA's Acting Administrator, Veronica Vanterpool. The 164-foot <u>Battery Steele</u>, which will use hybrid diesel-electric propulsion systems to reduce emissions and maintenance needs while increasing system efficiency, is one of the first hybrid, commuter vessels of its kind to be built in a Northeast shipyard.
